II CANDLE SHADES AND FRAMELESS LAMPSHADES Before attempting the more difficult task of covering a wire frame, the amateur shade maker may like to try a candle shade--a candle shade without a wire frame, that can be dropped over a shade holder. These shade holders can be bought in almost any department store; they fasten round the candle with a spring clip, which holds in place a rod with a circular wire at the top. The shade is dropped over this ring and supported at a sufficient distance from the candle flame to prevent scorching. In the case of very small shades however, especially if the shape has very little flare, it is safest to use a mica lining, as an impromptu fire at a dinner party adds a little too much to the excitement. These mica linings come in standard sizes and...
