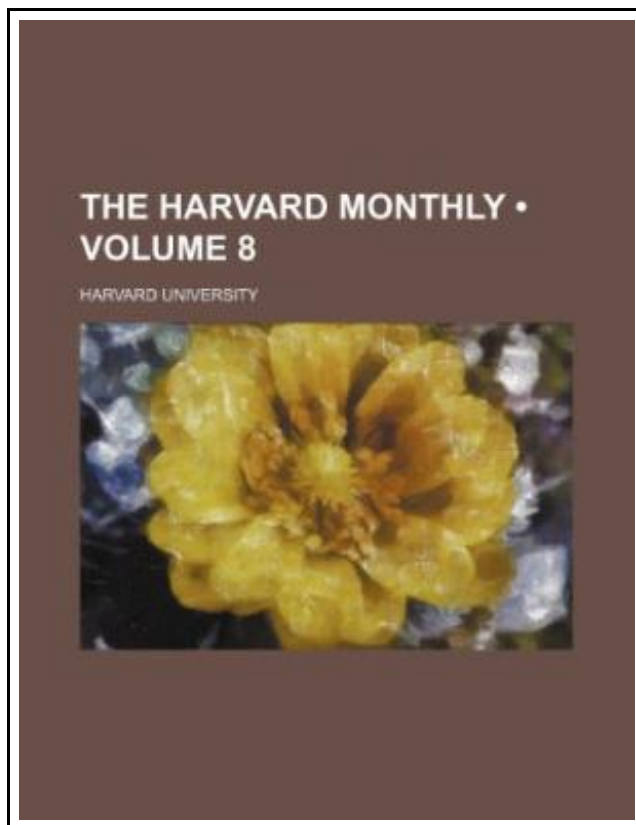

Indeed, there is room for doubt whether its amazing development of resources and of methods, since the year 1870, has not made it essentially more different from what it was then than it then was from the provincial college, which for a couple of centuries had graduated classes so small and so simple that each man knew every other. This change is beginning to be appreciated, People are beginning to wonder what manner of life goes on amid influences so new in American education. It has been my fortune to know this life pretty intimately for sixteen years. From 1872 to 1878 I was a student at Harvard; since 1880 I have been instructor there. Beginning work as a teacher so soon after I had ceased work as a pupil, I found myself in sympathy with the students to a degree perhaps unusual; and the nature of my work has kept me in close relation with them ever since. In the first place, the subject I have been teaching--English Composition--is still a part of the course prescribed to every undergraduate; in the second, I have been accustomed for five years to require from every pupil in my elective course what I call daily themes. These are in effect journals: each student writes a note of what each day...
