Upper-class scoundrel Basil Sealmad, bad, and dangerous to know creates havoc wherever he goes, much to the despair of his sister, his mother, and his mistress. Introduced in *Black Mischief* and returning in this 1942 novel, Basil realizes that Neville Chamberlain's declaration of war on Germany is the perfect opportunity to resume a career of action and adventure. So Basil follows the call to arms and sets forth to become a war hero. Yet his instincts for self-preservation come to the fore, and he insinuates himself into the Ministry of Information and a little-known section of Military Security, waiting for the "phony war" to become a real one. Named one of the era's "great masters of English prose" by *Time* and others, Waugh produced 16 novels, as well as several volumes of short fiction, biography, memoir, and essays. *A Handful of Dust*, *Scoop*, and *Brideshead Revisited* were all selected by the Modern Library as among the 100 best novels of the 20th century, while the *Sword of Honor* trilogy (*Men at Arms*, *Officers and Gentlemen*, and *Unconditional Surrender*) was deemed "the one genuine masterpiece to come out of World War II" (*New Republic*).
